Background:

In November 2008, the District released Request for Proposal No. 0809-10, Educational Master Planning Services, Districtwide, for the selection of a service provider to aid in developing educational master plans for the two Colleges, the Centers and the District. The purpose of this solicitation was to retain a firm with extensive, relevant experience to help develop and produce site-specific, comprehensive educational master plans which fully explain the overall purpose, community context, educational philosophy, curriculum, educational programs and related support, alternative delivery systems, student services, administrative and categorical programs of the District and its campuses. These educational master plans, required for any future funding applications to the State, will also justify the intended future of the District and will identify current and future needs while making a convincing case for new resources to meet these needs.

The District received seven proposals in response to this solicitation. These proposals were evaluated and ranked by the Colleges and Centers on the basis of the thoroughness of the firm's submission, their relevant experience in California Community College educational master planning, qualifications as submitted by the firm, evaluations and recommendations of clients, conformity with the requirements of the RFP, capacity to complete the project within defined parameters, and the level, background and experience of individuals to be assigned to perform the services. From the initial seven proposals, three consultant firms were selected to participate in an interview process. These three firms were interviewed by the College Presidents and the Vice Chancellor, North Centers, on January 14, 2009. Following the interviews, reference checks were performed and additional information was requested from the top two firms. At the conclusion of this process, a final recommendation was forwarded to the Chancellor.

After thorough consideration, the District administration is recommending the consultant firm of Maas Companies, Inc., located in North Fork, California, as the firm to provide consultant services to aid in developing separate educational master plan documents for Fresno City College, Reedley College, the North Centers, the new Southeast Center and an overarching summary plan for the District. Maas Companies has previously helped to develop 96 educational and facility master plans for California Community Colleges and has demonstrated success in maintaining trust and effective communication with all constituency groups involved in the planning process.

Fiscal Impact:

Funding for the educational master planning process will be provided by the 2008-09 and 2009-10 General Fund. The District will fund the first \$150,000.00 of the planning process with the Colleges and Centers funding the remaining balance. The estimated overall fee for the educational master plan consultant services as proposed is as follows:

The services to be provided by College/Center staff will include giving information to and referring students and families to Medi-Cal/Healthy Families insurance programs, facilitating the completion of application materials, or referring students and families to medical health services. The program is funded through the Federal Title XIX program. The Madera County Superintendent of Schools is serving as the agency responsible for the coordination of Medi-Cal Administrative Activities (MAA) for Region VII of the California County Superintendent's Educational Services Association (Fresno, Kings, Madera, Mariposa, Merced and Tulare Counties), in accordance with California Welfare and Institution Code Section 14132.47. As such, the Madera County Office of Education will ensure compliance with federal laws and regulations, train staff as necessary to ensure compliance, oversee the time survey process, review and submit all necessary documents and receive/distribute the funding to the appropriate agencies. The Madera County Office of Education will be compensated 6% from the claims paid for the Colleges/Centers providing the services.
