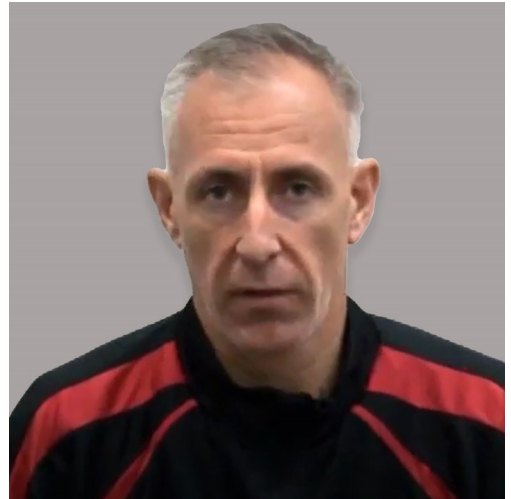
Suspect Name & Description

Name: Edward George Madec

Suspect: Adult, Male, 51 years old, Caucasian

Hair: Grey; **Eyes:** Blue

Height: 6' 4"; **Weight:** 225 lbs.



On August 15, 2023, at approximately 9:00 a.m. while teaching a class, Mr. Madec allegedly made threats against College Officials and Students in general, stating that he would shoot them. Following this incident, Ed Madec was promptly placed on Administrative Leave, and a Criminal Investigation was initiated. Subsequently, an Arrest Warrant was issued for the suspect.

On October 13, 2023, at approximately 2:00 p.m., Edward Madec was arrested in Merced County. No weapons were in his possession at the time of his arrest. Madec was then transported and booked into the Fresno County Jail. Later. He has since posted bail and been released.

With Mr. Madec's release and with the gravity of the threats he allegedly made, the SCCCDD Police Department is deeply concerned that the alleged suspect may pose a serious and ongoing threat to Fresno City College students and staff. If you encounter Edward Madec on the FCC campus, we strongly urge you not to confront him. Instead, please call SCCCDD PD immediately at (559) 244-6140, or dial 9-1-1 to report his presence and let law enforcement handle the situation. Your safety and that of the college community are of paramount importance.
