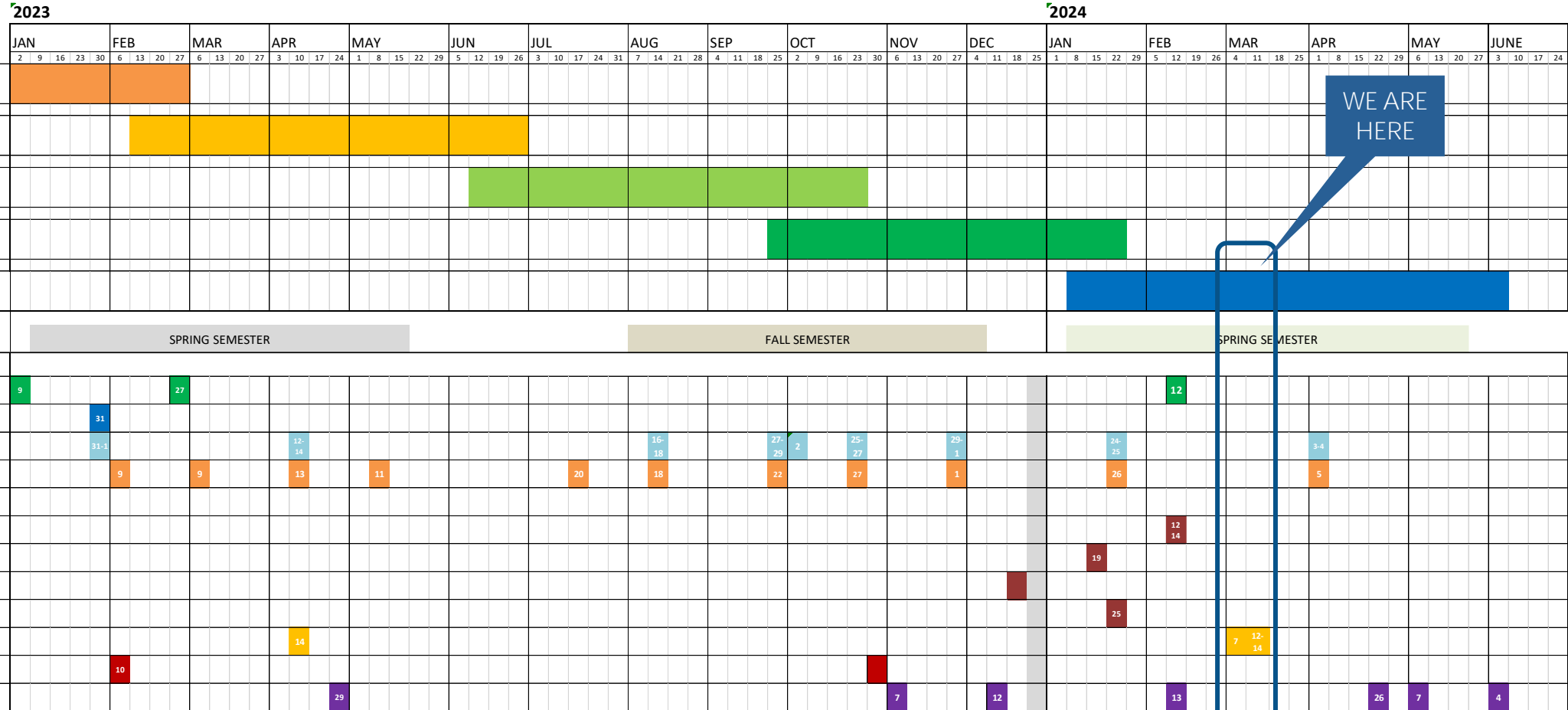

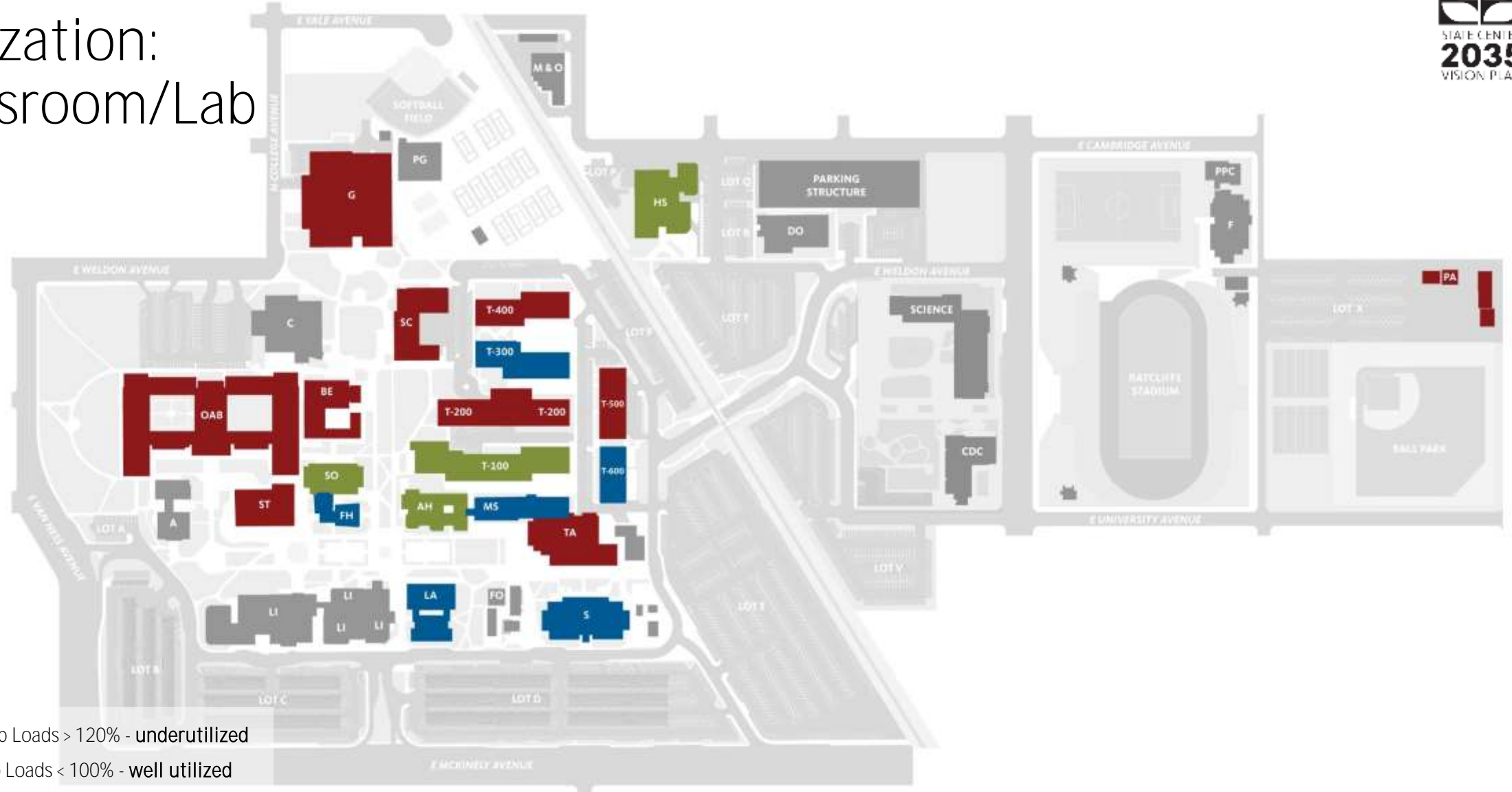

- On Target Cap Loads 100% - 120%

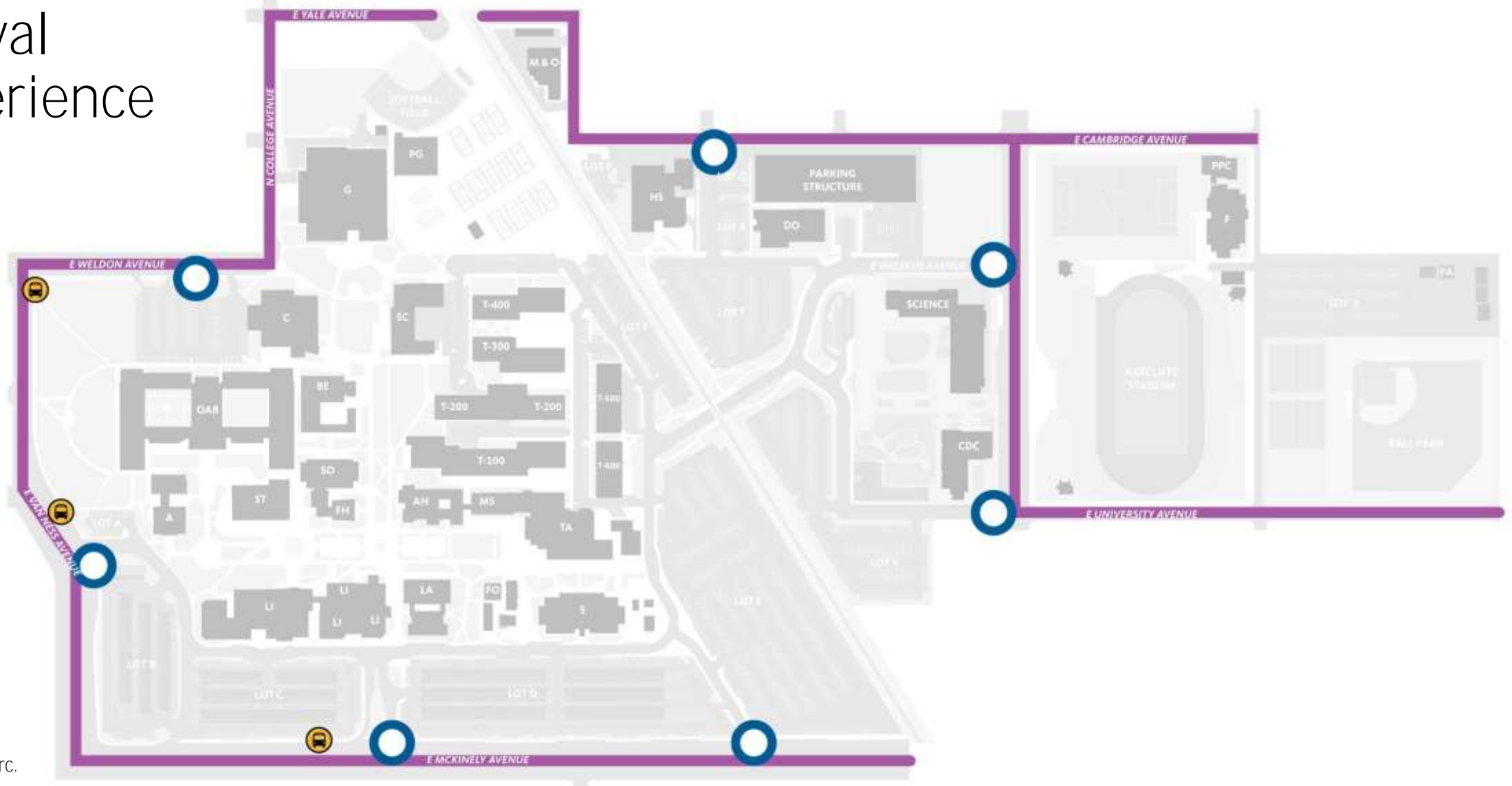

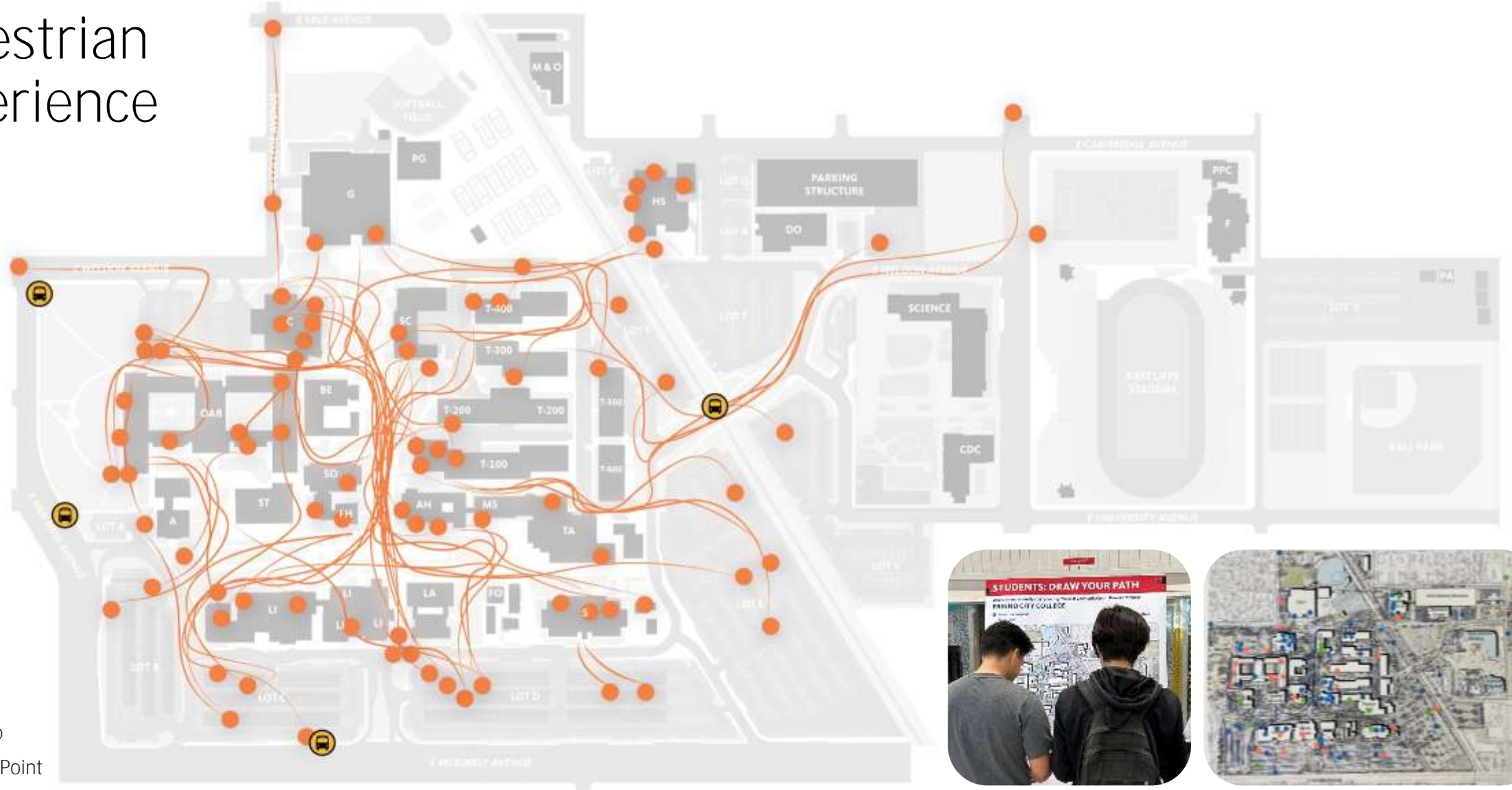

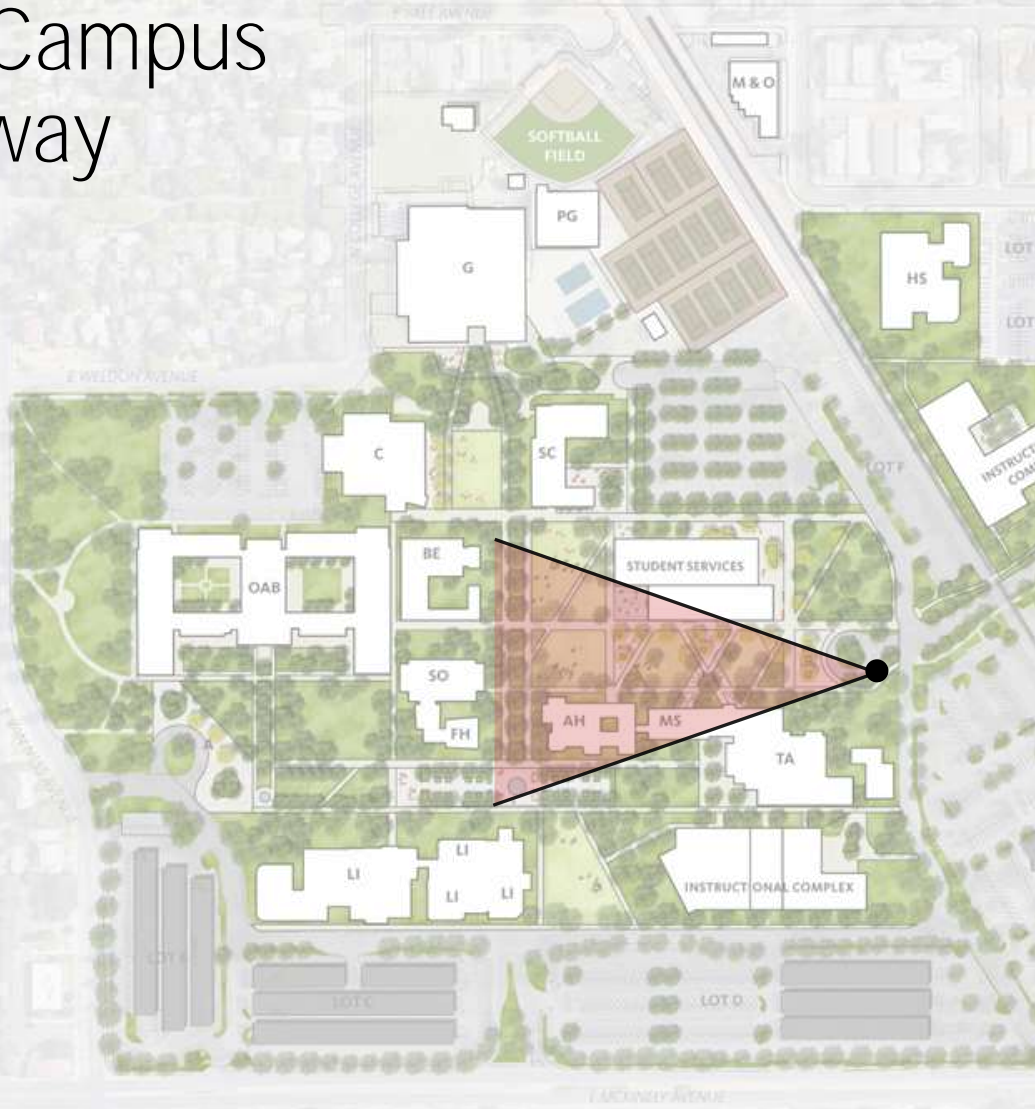
Landscape Plan



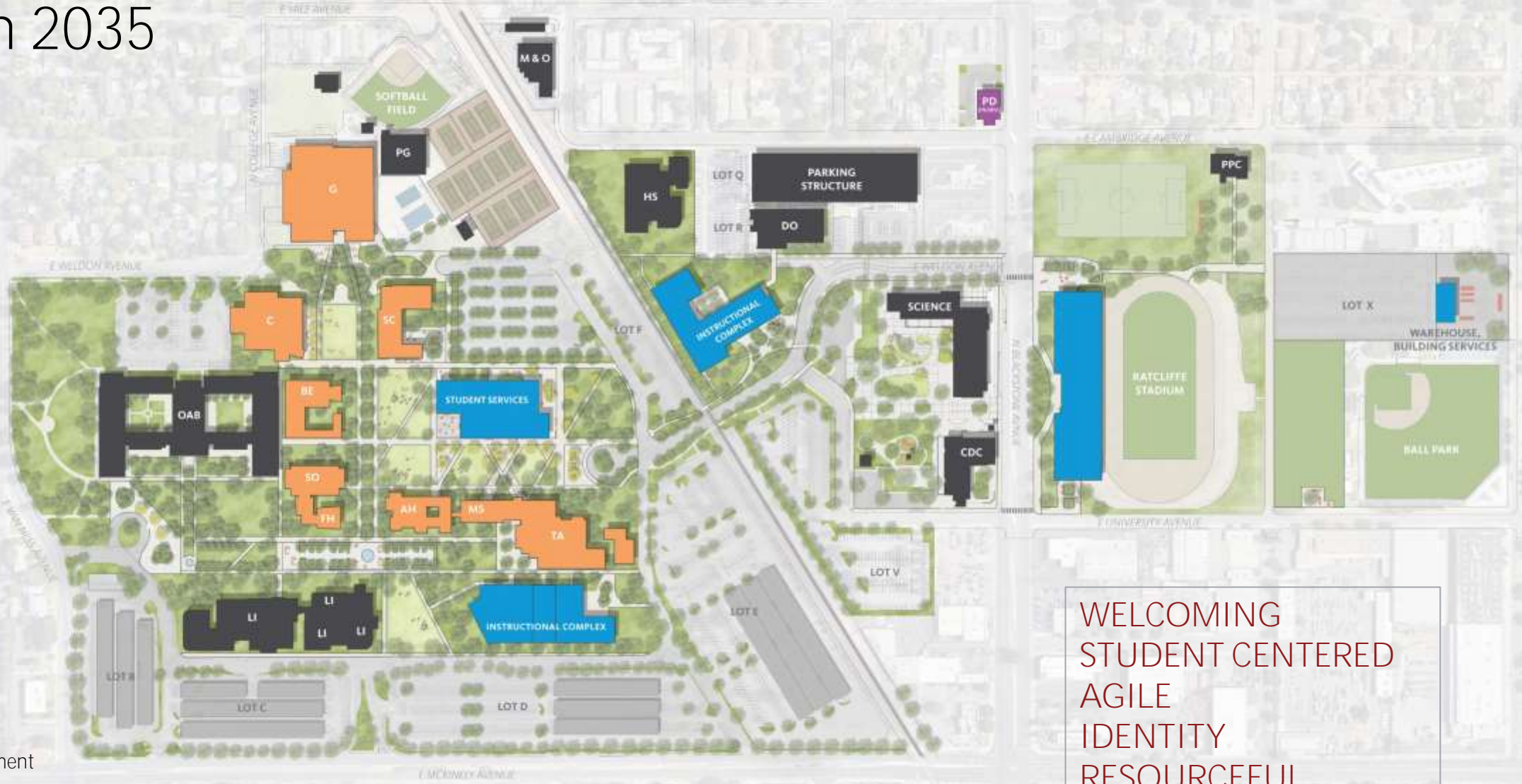

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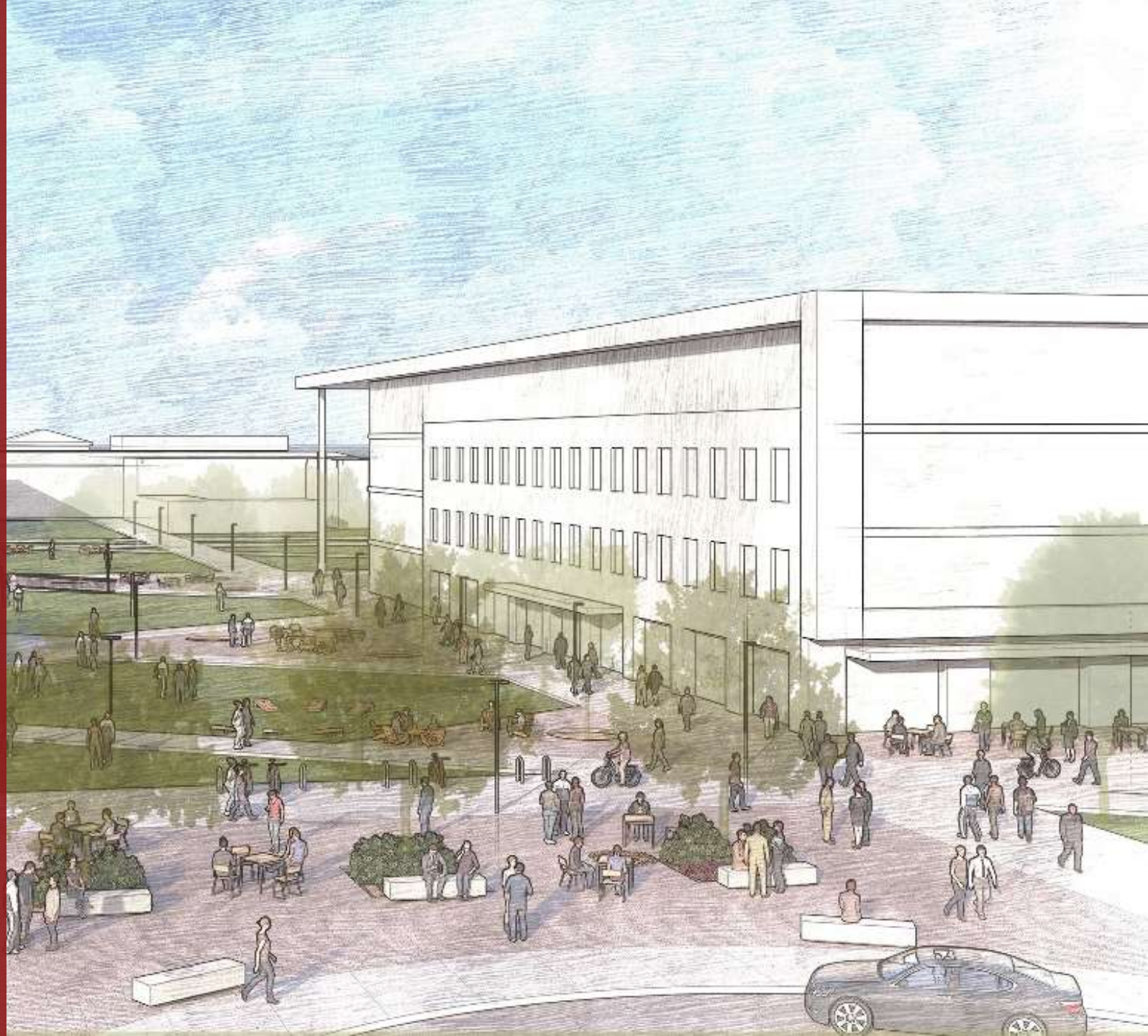
