CURRENT STATUS



- ✓ Second year of the program
 - Freshman Class: 40 students
 - Sophomore Class: 21 students
- ✓ Recruitment period resulted in a full freshman class with a substantial waiting list
- ✓ The grant for RMCHS, awarded to RC, is a recurring state grant supporting the location and college staff
- ✓ Student enrollment, services, teachers, and oversight are the responsibility of KCUSD

EXPANSION AND PERMANENT LOCATION AT REEDLEY COLLEGE

- ✓ Temporary location by the Library in the PORTABLES
- ✓ Includes four rooms with 40-student capacity
- ✓ Lacks adequate labs and support facilities
- ✓ Insufficient space for growth
- ✓ Current space is centrally located and needed by the college
- ✓ RC has open space available

CONSIDERATIONS FOR FALL 2017*

- 1. <u>SITE LOCATION</u>. Tentatively selected as the north end of the campus, east of the AGNR greenhouse. Facilities Committee and constituency input in progress.
- KCUSD has agreed to conduct a <u>NEEDS ASSESSMENT</u> (600-800 students).
- KCUSD has agreed to use Darden & Associates to develop <u>SITE PLANS</u>
- 4. KCUSD is considering <u>FUNDING OPTIONS</u> including:
 - a. construction costs
 - b. maintenance/custodial
 - c. operating utilities
- 5. RC is considering impacts related to:
 - a. student volume
 - b. traffic flow
 - c. parking
