State Center 2035 Vision Plan Impact on College Planning


The Colleges will

- May be unique to each College

- Guide the development, review, and Districtwide vetting of State Center 2035
- Analyze and discuss key findings and recommendations
- Serve as first readers to review and comment on drafts


