▶ DISTRICT DEMOGRAPHICS
2020 CENSUS DATA

- Validated redistricting data was released by the California Department of Finance on September 20.
- This data showed substantial changes in the area served by SCCCD from 2010 to 2020, including:
 - Overall population growth of over 90,000 (8.8%);
 - Changes in the demographic composition, most notably, increases in the proportional share of Hispanic/Latino and Asian populations.
- In the portions served by SCCCD, all counties grew except for Kings County, which represents a small portion, both of the County and SCCCD overall.






