In compliance with the "Timely Warning" provisions of the federal Clery Act of 1998, State Center Community College District Police Department is providing the Fresno City College campus community notice of the following reported criminal allegation:

False imprisonment (Penal Code 236), and Indecent Exposure (Penal Code 314)

Suspect Description

Suspect: Unknown Black Male Adult **Hair**: Short, Black, Curly; **Height**: 5'9"; **Weight**: 130 lbs. **Wearing**: White T-Shirt, Unknown Color Pants, White High-Top Sneakers.

On Thursday, October 6, 2022, at about 3:00 pm, a Female student reported to SCCCD PD that she had been seated on the second-floor bench of the Social Science building when an unknown Black Male Adult approached her. She quickly realized the man had his pants down, exposing his genitals and masturbating in front of her.

When the victim attempted to flee, the alleged suspect used both arms to grab her shoulders and retrain her movement. She fought off her attacker, broke free, and fled. A few minutes later, the victim saw the subject had found and followed her. she was finally able to escape when she incorporated herself into a group of students she encountered near the Student Services Building. The suspect fled the area, and the responding officers did not locate him.

SCCCD PD believes the alleged suspect, in this case, represents a continuing threat to SCCCD students and staff. If you see anyone on campus matching the above description and exhibiting similar behavior on the FCC campus, we urge you not to confront him but call SCCCD PD immediately at (559) 244-6140 or dial 9-1-1.
