## MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING AND AGREEMENT BY AND BETWEEN STATE CENTER COMMUNITY COLLEGE DISTRICT AND STATE FEDERATION OF TEACHERS, LOCAL 1533 February 3, 3023

This non-precedent setting Memorandum of Understanding ("MOU") is entered into by and between the STATE CENTER COMMUNITY COLLEGE DISTRICT (hereinafter referred to as the "District") and the STATE CENTER FEDERATION OF TEACHERS, LOCAL 1533, CFT/AFT, AFL-CIO (hereinafter referred to as "Federation"). The parties have reached agreement on the provisions set forth below. All language currently in effect as stated in the Agreement between the parties will remain unchanged except as set forth below.

The parties agree to meet in the 2023-2024 academic year, along with representatives from the Academic Senates, to attempt to develop a recommended policy and procedure for dual enrollment, and if developed, then present to the Chancellor for consideration on or before February 1, 2024.

The parties agree that the terms of this MOU are non-precedential and will not constitute any waiver of any rights not specifically addressed in this agreement.

The signatories signify that they are the authorized representatives of the District and Federation, as the proper parties to this MOU; that all actions necessary for the parties to ratify and accept this MOU as a binding and bilateral agreement will be immediately completed in the manner required by that party or by law.

This MOU is made the 3rd day of February 2023, in the City of Fresno, County of Fresno, State of California.
