Comments from site facilities committee:

- Need a warehouse, shipping, receiving & storage all in one central area
- Storage for cleaning supplies
- Tables, chairs, canopies and stage all need storage
- Student services has outgrown its space. Health office is not adequate.
- No bathroom
- No confidential Exam Rooms
- No Lactation Space
- No room for Psychological Services

Are the future buildings set in stone?

- The College is busting at the seams
- Tutorial center has been outgrown
- Student Center is needed
- Food service (cafeteria) is needed
- Parking is becoming a problem
- Library is too small
- Not adequate meeting space
- No break rooms for staff
- Food and clothing “closet” needed for students
- Need additional space for large group instruction, to accommodate a guest speaker
- Business Office is not adequate for students coming in
- Outdoor assembly space would be useful
- Trash compactor and recycling center needed
- Teaching spaces are maxed out

Labs & Classrooms

- Need some classrooms that will hold 50
- Need to accommodate flexible learning strategies
- Math Department classes are capped at 45 students
- Biology spaces are one of the campuses top majors
- Why are student classes higher at Clovis Campus?
