2. MASTER PLAN PROCESS

- a. Purpose is to project and plan for 2030.
- b. Funding is dependent on need; however, it is important to establish and prioritize a list of concerns for future work.

3. CURRENT FACILITIES MASTER PLAN

- a. Original Reedley College campus buildings are still slated for future demolition due to FCI scores.

4. EDUCATIONAL MASTER PLAN

- a. The educational master plan helps feed the Facility Master plan.

5. FACILITY MASTER PLAN

- a. Updated space utilization report needs to be reviewed for Reedley Campus.
- b. Open Discussion.

MEETING NOTES

1. DISABLED STUDENT PROGRAM AND SERVICES

- a. DSPS is not identified on the previous Master Plan.
- b. DSPS services many students on campus and currently has a small space, in an inconvenient place on campus.
- c. **Potential Facility Needs:**
 - i. It was requested that the DSPS have a confidential space, in a readily accessible place on the campus.
 - ii. A private testing, counseling, and tutoring space specifically for DSPS students was requested.

2. ATHLETICS

- a. The athletics department has now acquired a *Women's Soccer* and *Women's Equestrian* Team.
 - i. To be eligible to compete in a league, the *Women's Equestrian* Team needs to be able to host a competition event. They are currently using another campus to host events.
- b. A Wellness Center for Fitness and Physical Therapy was requested.

- c. Locker Room upgrades were requested.
- d. Floors in current Athletic buildings are in needs of a modernization; especially the Weight Room.
- e. **Potential Facility Needs:**
 - i. The Women's Soccer Team and the Football Team request to have a multiuse shared 'Home' Field or Stadium for both games and practice.
 - ii. A Stadium with a tower for practice and game recordings.
 - iii. A track area for Athletic training or Wellness and Physical therapy was requested.
 - iv. Accessible access to Baseball fields were a request.

3. COLLEGE OUTREACH

- a. College Outreach is the 'Welcome Center' of the campus.
- b. They often give tours of the campus and they currently are not located in the best place.
- c. They currently meet potential students in Parking lots for tours.
- d. **Potential Facility Needs:**
 - i. Physical Welcome Center to meet with potential students and give guidance to enrolled students.

4. SCIENCE PROGRAMS

- a. The additional building could not accommodate desired programmatic spaces; however, the Dental and Nursing program was able to move back on Reedley Campus.
- b. **Potential Facility Needs:**
 - i. The Physics and Engineering Programs need new physical space, due to lack of programmatic space in new Science building.

5. FINE ARTS

- a. The new performing arts building will address specific needs, but will not provide new/updated physical space for other medians of art i.e. ceramic, painting, etc.

6. 'GUIDED PATHWAYS'

- a. Guided Pathways is the current method of navigating Reedley Community College.
- b. Should be a physical space that students can go to accomplish practical task for enrollment, and a place to meet a physical person to receive guidance on any subject.
- c. LA Trade Tech is Reedley College's precedent example.
- d. A reorganization of space might help guided pathways before a permanent space is built.
- e. **Potential Facility Needs:**
 - i. A building that is centrally located to help connect students.
 - ii. A physical place to either informally congregate or formally meet with students.
 - iii. Could either be Flex or Permanent space but would be helpful to be in a place where students already gather.

7. AG COMPLEX

- a. The existing building is still being utilized effectively.
- b. Potential yet unclear concerns about the Forestry Program.
- c. The addition of a Farm Store was requested to be apart of a new Ag Complex.

8. SHOPS

- a. **Potential Facility Needs:**

- i. Numerous shop spaces are undersized or lacking space for growth.
 - 1. Wood Shop
 - 2. Heavy Truck Manufacturing
 - 3. Ag Manufacturing

9. LIBRARY

- a. No representatives from the Library Department were present, however some were aware of general concerns.
- b. **Potential Facility Needs:**
 - i. Additions of Quiet Areas, Storage, Small Work Groups space, and Training Space for Library Staff and students.

10. POLICE DEPARTMENT

- a. Police Officers who are assigned to the Reedley College Area report at the beginning and end of their shifts to the District Office. The commute time is inefficient.
- b. **Potential Facility Needs:**
 - i. The Police Department requested a small space on campus to report and operate in.
 - ii. A small space to deal with the Duties necessary to be an effective support system on campus.

11. CUSTODIAN

- a. Currently not able to store the necessary items to maintain buildings or are sharing space with other functions of buildings.
- b. **Potential Facility Needs:**
 - i. Larger standardized space in every building for custodial storage is needed. Or, a large space separate from any building to support the custodial staff.
 - ii. Larger Walkways for cart driving.
