### Exterior Concept Development

Jonathan presented the overall Site and Floor plans and exterior design, see attached for comments. Specifically, the group requested:

- Group liked metal panel on top and bottom of north window bay. Some thought fins at North windows was too much but understood the solar protection it provided.
- Most wanted to see “heavy” material at the Office / Lecture base which could be granite.
- Group liked the idea of an interesting mural on stair
- After a long discussion on parking, the group agreed it should be completely secured to protect against homeless. Open to metal screen infill; need to see options. Some liked the idea of it visually being open.
- Shirley liked “random” window scheme for the Dean’s Suite.
- Concerned the stair would be a skateboard/bike ramp or jump.
- Would like East roof access stair be used to have telescope on roof. Jonathan said there are exiting issues to address if this is done.
- Group thought rotating the building five degrees on the site was good
- Half group liked wood on exterior others did not. Lionakis to study options.
- Group wanted “bookend” look with materials at east and west ends, not three different materials.
- Majority wanted organized windows on south side but open to some randomness.
- Some were concerned the white color on building would be “too white”.
- Group thought science should be on campus side of building and college name on other.
- Group didn’t like lettering on college name side being two directions. Preferred reading either vertical or horizontal.
- Most liked elevator being glass

### Interior Concept Development

Aaron presented the overall interior design, see attached for comments. Specifically, the group requested:

- Make sure collaboration space outside of labs do not promote large groups and has built in element to reduce sound transfer into labs.
- Study how much privacy is in the office with “frosted glass” either at middle section or all the way to the floor. It was agreed that in general it would be best if all the offices were the same.
- The “fins” in the corridor outside the labs were liked in concept but need to be redesigned per the preferred image from the Visual Preference exercise. Perhaps they might match the offices.
- George will provide the District’s furniture supplier’s contact.
