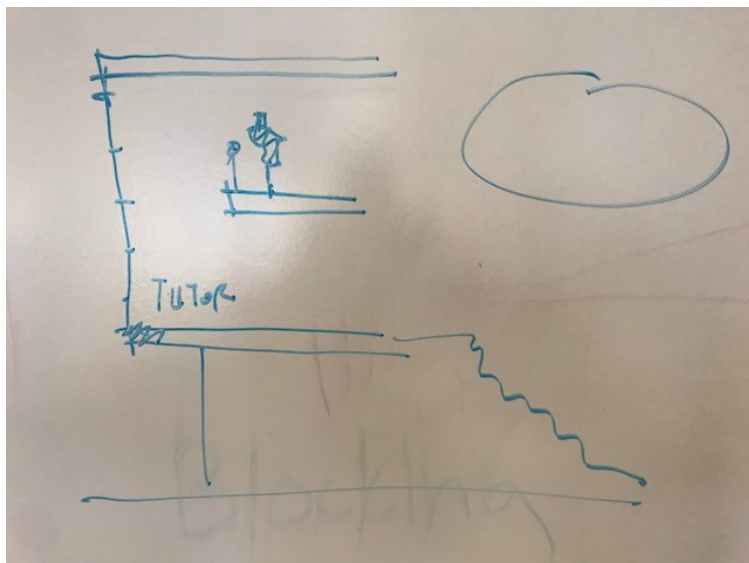

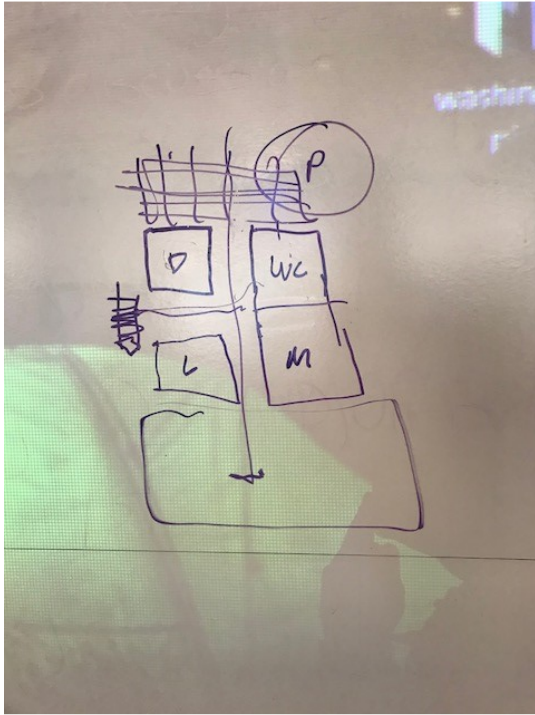

Jonathan and Aaron presented the revised floor plans options, see attached. Preferred 2nd and 3rd floor plans are indicated within a red box. Specifically, the group confirmed:

- There is no value in having lecture rooms in the middle of the building on the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> floors.
- Large lecture must be on the first floor
- Do not like the disruption at the prep spaces from south 3<sup>rd</sup> stair.
  - Would like to see an option of 3rd stair on north side of building
- Tutor area does not need a closed “office” can be open or have small breakout conference rooms.
- Move the Tutor space moving to second floor
- Liked the idea of a large open space between the 2nd and 3rd floor (see sketch below) pending a rendering.



- Computer lab can be a “glass box” should be able to seat 36 or more. Computer lab should be a closeable and lockable space.
- The two lecture halls on second floor should be equally sized.
- The group discussed what the Welcome Center should be. It was generally agreed that instead of a closed “office” with cubicles and a help counter, it should be an open space near the north end of the building. It should accommodate student gathering, both formal and informal.
- The group agreed on the arrangement of the Museum, Welcome Center, Dean’s Office and Large lecture per the sketch (not to scale) below. See next page.



- The connection to both a north plaza and a shaded south plaza should be open and welcoming with the ability to enter either south or north end and walk all the way through the first floor. The west interior stair should also connect the first floor and the second floor.
