In June 2016, voters approved Measure C which provides \$485 million dollars for

capital projects District wide. The District will also be spending \$30 million in Measure E funds and other local and state capital project funding all of which must be managed efficiently.

At its February meeting following a detailed RFQ process, the Board of Trustees approved a list of companies qualified to provide professional construction management, architectural and environmental services for Measure C capital projects. Now, after the work of the Fresno City College, Reedley College and Madera Community College

firms proposed by those committees to the Board for action at its March meeting. The projects these firms will be working on are Fresno City College Planning, Reedley College Science Facility expansion and the Madera Community College Center Manufacturing Facility expansion.


Fresno City College Fresno City College held its architect selection meeting on January 27, 2017 to select a
