Items Discussed

Allied Health Department:

Questions/Ideas:

- Testing on tablets? Concern would be with students cheating. Use desktop dividers.
- Laptops? Issue of storage and setting them up and who will provide them?
- Could CPR occur in the large purple room? More room for storage.
- Do we need all the hospital beds? Eliminate the number of them.
- Do we need the stress test equipment? Or can we keep them elsewhere?
- Reduce the cabinets in the classroom?

Admin/Counseling Department:

Questions/Ideas:

- They were curious if the work room would have room for teachers who do not have an office?
- Are counselor offices set up for confidentiality?
- Is the computer space necessary since we are doing only pre-req courses?
- Should we reduce the computer lab?
- Cut classrooms downstairs – Financial Aid and Enrollment
- Reduce second floor classroom, second floor computer room, and first floor admin.
- Enrollment not needed since its mainly online.

Kinesiology Department:

Questions/Ideas:

- Discussion centered around student vs faculty showers.
- Should we eliminate other items to make room for student showers?
- Is the computer space necessary since we are doing only pre-req courses?
- What will the flooring be in there? Concerned about it being sanitary and multi-function.
- Can we add the showers to the main restrooms?

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Outcome:

First Floor

- There is not enough in the budget to do the Kinesiology lab to the college's standards. We need to push this to second phase.
- Recess main entry glass into the lobby, matching the depth of the wing wall on the opposite side of the multipurpose room.
- Reduce the large tiered lecture classroom down to 76-person and cut space on both the North and South. This classroom will need to shift West to account for the LRC reduction above.
- To account for the plan reductions on the 2nd floor:
 - Remove the general office
 - Remove (1) Community Outreach Space
 - Remove (1) enrollment space
 - Remove portions of the yellow lobby and green campus center green space
 - Reduce the width of the workroom, which will also cut some from the conference room, electrical, and MDF. To balance the Electrical and MDF, stretch the walls down into the workroom more to keep the same approximate 100 SF in each.

Second Floor

- Remove the casework in the medical assisting classroom to shrink room by 2'-6" and remove one curtained hospital bed in the medical assisting lab and reorganize accordingly.
- Change the tables in the (3) standard classrooms 18" wide, similar to other classrooms on the FCC campus, and take 3'-0" out of the width of each of these (3) classrooms.
- Change the 48-person computer classroom to 32-person to balance that side of the corridor with the cuts from the bottom half.
- Take approximately 10'-0" in width from the LRC by removing one (1) study room and shrinking the quiet room.
- Remove the vending machine spaces, as the bookstore will have reach-in coolers to sell drinks.

Total square footage reduction: approx. 6,000

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
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
FIRST FLOOR
